REMINDERS - FULFILL BEFORE GRADUATION

- ALL GRADES below a "C" must be repeated before graduation - University Policy.
- Only those students who have completed at least three fourths of their degree program are eligible to enroll in a practicum and must be cleared by the Office of Clinical and Field Experiences
- All graduate students matriculating in a degree program must be continuously enrolled at Alabama State University.
- Applicants seeking admission to a degree program in The Murphy Graduate School are to submit passing scores on the ASU Graduate Writing Competency Test (GWCT) by the end of the first semester of enrollment. Registration for a second term will not be permitted without having passed the GWCT.
- The student must maintain a cumulative average grade of 3.0 (B) or higher in required and elective graduate courses. (3.25 for Ed.S)
- Students must complete and pass all required written and/or oral comprehensive exams and theses/dissertations as required by the specific degree program
