### **Job Description**

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is offering a paid temporary internship for Biology majors in the Montgomery, AL area. All years of college students are encouraged to apply including Masters and Doctoral Program students. The intern will work within ALDOT's cutting edge Environmental Technical Section in the Design Bureau assessing environmental studies.

### **Primary Responsibilities**

- Review Waters of the U.S. (WOTUS) and Habitat Assessment reports for consultant-led projects
- Assist in the development of field survey plans for proposed projects, including habitat assessments and wetland and stream delineations
- Gain familiarity with project scopes and environmental compliance requirements
- Collaborate with internal ALDOT Design Bureau staff and coordinate with external liaisons, including the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE).
- Determine habitat suitability for federally listed species (may include bat structure surveys within bridges and culverts).
- Other duties as assigned

Upon successful completion, career opportunities may be available as a Professional Environmental Specialist, and/or a full-time position as a Biology Graduate.
