

Internship Opportunity

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is looking for a college student currently studying Science, Math, or Drafting who wants to be placed in a paid internship, located in the West Central Region in Fayette, AL with a start date to be determined.

Job Description

ALDOT is offering a paid temporary internship for Science, Math, or Drafting majors in the Fayette, AL area. All years of college students are encouraged to apply including Masters and Doctoral Program students. The internship will be located at the West Central Area Office in Fayette, AL.

Primary Responsibilities

- Perform soils and topsoil tests, such as moisture content, moisture correction, gradation, -200
 wash, Liquid/Plastic Limit, PH, organic burn, hydrometer, Proctor Density, and shrinkage limit in
 the Area Laboratory to determine the suitability of materials and conformity to specifications with
 minimum errors.
- Perform tests on aggregates in the Area Laboratory, such as moisture correction, -200 wash, and moisture content.
- Performs tests on bituminous material in the Area Laboratory, such as rice, dry back, gyrate, or compact pills.
- Visually inspect all aspects of the plant operation, including but not limited to stockpiles for contamination and segregation, cold feed bins for proper operation, asphalt mixtures for segregation and drain-down, or any other unusual conditions.
- Leads in/performs the log-in/check-in of referee samples daily into locked cages on the dock and supervises the gathering of required referee samples to be sent to Montgomery with accuracy and no loss of time to the process.
- Other duties as assigned
