

Overview of the Rehabilitation Counseling Curriculum

To complete the Master of Science in Rehabilitation Counseling program, students must successfully complete a minimum of fifty-one (51) semester hours and complete a comprehensive examination. Due to the sequential nature of courses in the curriculum, incoming full-time students enroll for the fall semester and remain in the program for five (5) consecutive academic semesters.
