

# ASU CARES Program for Students that did not file a FAFSA

The CARES Act created through the US Department of Education provides a financial grant for colleges and universities to award funding to eligible students affected due to the coronavirus. Funds may only be used to cover expenses students incurred due to the disruption of campus operations. Eligible expenses for funding include cost of attendance items such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care.

According to the *Frequently Asked Questions about the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under Section 18004 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act* developed by the United States Department of Education, a student who has demonstrated eligibility to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (HEA), by filing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for academic year 2019-2020 is eligible to receive an emergency financial aid grant from ASU. Students who did not file a FAFSA are also eligible to receive an emergency financial aid grant from ASU if you are U.S. citizenship or eligible noncitizen; have a valid Social Security number; registered with Selective Service (if the student is male); and have obtained a high school diploma, GED, or completed a high school in an approved homeschool setting.
