

PROPOSED  
Graduate Course Repeat Policy

Effective Fall Term 2013, graduate students admitted to a program of study may repeat no more than one course **with forgiveness** when a grade of less than “C” is earned. When such a course is repeated, the first attempt will be excluded from the student’s graduate grade point average. All subsequent repeats will be included in the student’s overall graduate grade point average.

Grades of “C” **or higher** may not be repeated and no more than three grades of “C” **(9 credit hours)** may be included in a graduate program of study. Students earning more than three grades of “C” will be considered not in good graduate standing and may be dismissed. To remain in good graduate standing, graduate students must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least a 3.0 on all graduate work during their program period. **(Please note that this policy is based upon the assumption that courses represent three credit hours in each case. Courses with any other credit-hour variation will be handled on a case-by-case basis.)**
