*The Alabama State University EPP Employment Rate for 2022-2023 is **94%**. The rate is based on **(13)** Class-B/Undergraduate initial program completers and **(4) OF THE (5)** Class-A/Alternative program completers from Fall 2022 and Spring 2023. A total of **(17)** completers were hired to begin teaching in the academic year following their completion of the program requirements. ASU graduates are currently employed in a variety of roles throughout the state of Alabama and the southeast. Graduates are employed in school systems throughout the region such as **Montgomery, Jefferson, Butler, Barrow (GA), and Atlanta Public Schools (GA)**, to name a few.
